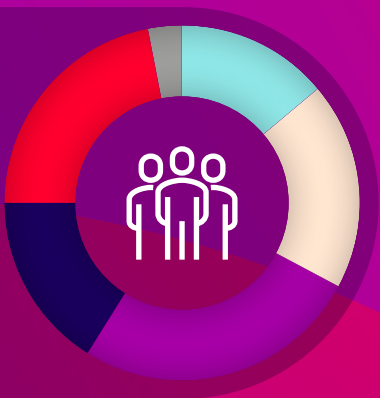


AUDIENCE DEMOGRAPHICS

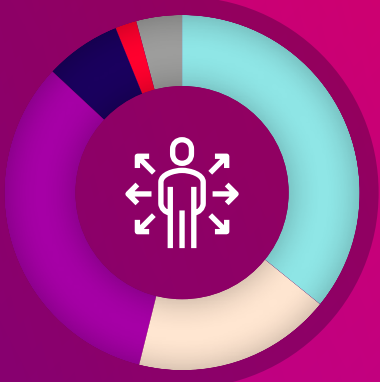
BREAKDOWN OF GEOGRAPHY
